

Mathematics:

The main focus this term is knowing times tables up to 12x12 quickly, place value, the 4 operations (+ - x ÷) and fractions.

English:

This term we are writing narratives, persuasive texts and balanced discussions. Your child will be heard read individually in class and take part in Whole Class Reading sessions practising a variety of skills.

Science:

Our Science will focus on Living Things. We will be learning about Evolution and Inheritance (including changes over time and adaptation) and Classification including microorganisms.

Music:

Each week children will be participating in a virtual music lesson held online by Dudley Performing Arts.

RE:

This term we are learning about Buddhism and Islam and our school values are creativity and justice.

PSHE:

Alongside our school values we will be exploring healthy lifestyles and democracy.

Computing:

The main focus this term will be E-Safety, including how to stay safe with social media.

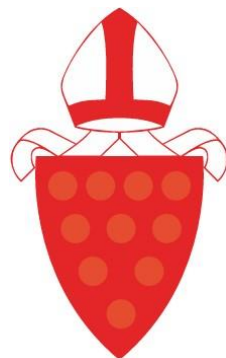
P.E:
