

Maths:

The main focus this term is place value, addition and subtraction. We will also explore 2D and 3D shape. Please practise correct number formation at home with your child.

English:

This term we will be practising our writing skills, developing descriptive writing and instructions. Weekly Reading lessons will focus on building fluency and comprehension.

P.E:

Our PE lessons are every Tuesday afternoon. All children are required to take part in PE lessons and should wear appropriate PE kit on this day: black leggings or jogging bottoms, a white t-shirt and trainers or pumps. They may wear their school jumper/cardigan. Many of our PE sessions are outside so it is advisable that your child has kit appropriate for all weather.

No jewellery is permitted for health and safety reasons. Earrings must be taken out at home or covered with a plaster before PE day. We cannot take earrings out or supply plasters at school.

Reading Books

Your child is given a reading book every week to read at home. Please take the time to listen to them read 2 or 3 times per week and sign their reading record log.

Reading books must be brought into school **every day** so that we can hear your child read in school too.

Science:

Our Science will focus on plants: how they grow, what they need and their lifecycles. We will also explore the basic needs of animals.

Music:

Each week children will be participating in a virtual music lesson using the Oak Academy programme.

RE/PSHE:

This term we are exploring the values of thankfulness and truthfulness. Across the term, we will also explore Harvest, Remembrance Day and Christmas customs. PSHE will focus on healthy food, friendships and anti-bullying.

Our school values are thankfulness and truthfulness.

Art:

We will be studying landscapes, famous landscape artists and our trip to the black country museum will develop this further.

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**Computing:**

The children will be learning about how to stay safe on the internet and start developing their digital presentation skills.

Geography:

Geography this term will include looking at our local area: Where we live, our address, our town and what is around us.

Homework

Maths, English and spellings homework will be given out every Tuesday and will need to be returned on the following Tuesday. Late homework will not be marked.

Children will be responsible for bringing in their own homework and if they lose their homework book, they will need to inform their class teacher straight away.

Reminders:

Your child must have a coat in school every day, even if it's not raining.

Water bottles need to be labelled and can only have water in them- no juice or fizzy pop.

Label jumpers and coats to avoid any losses.

Hair accessories need to be school colours and studs only for earrings. Hair must be tied back.
