#### **Mathematics:**

The main focus this term is knowing times tables up to 12x12, place value, the 4 operations (+ - x  $\div$ ) and fractions.

## **English:**

This term we are writing descriptions, poems, writing as journalists and interesting our audience through non-fiction writing. Your child will be heard read individually in class and take part in Whole Class Reading sessions.

P.E: Our PE lessons are on a Thursday afternoon. All children are required to take part in PE lessons and should wear appropriate PE kit on this day: black leggings, shorts or jogging bottoms, a plain white t-shirt and trainers or pumps. We advise they wear their school jumper/cardigan. Many of our PE sessions are outside so it is advisable that your child has kit appropriate for all weather. In wet weather, trainers are advisable.

No jewellery is permitted for health and safety reasons. Please leave getting ears pierced until the summer holidays. If your child does have their ears pierced, a plaster must be put on at home. Please ensure that hair is tied back.
