

Mathematics:

Units covered this term include: ratio; algebra; decimals; fractions, decimals and percentages; area, perimeter and volume; statistics.

English:

We are beginning our assessment pieces (newspaper report, story and balanced argument). Your child will be heard read individually and take part in Whole Class Reading sessions practising a variety of skills.

Science:

Our Science will focus on the classification and evolution of living things.

Music:

Each week children will be participating in a music lesson taught by a member of staff from Dudley Performing Arts. Our focus this half term is singing in multiple parts.

RE:

This term we are continuing the Christianity Project answering the question 'Was Jesus the Messiah? We will also be exploring how Christians celebrate Easter. Our school values this term are trust and forgiveness.

PSHE:

Alongside our school values we will be exploring the work of charities.

ICT:

This term we will using Scratch to code an animation.


P.E:

Topic:
