

Mathematics:

This term we will be learning formal written methods for multiplication and division; revision on written methods for addition and subtraction; calculating with fractions; learning about length and perimeter; mass and capacity - with a focus on times tables throughout all units.

English:

During Spring term we will complete a meeting tale, a persuasive piece of writing and a poem. Your child will be heard read individually and take part in Whole Class Reading sessions,

P.E:

Our PE lessons are on a Monday afternoon. All children are required to take part in PE lessons and should wear appropriate PE kit on this day: black leggings, shorts or jogging bottoms; a plain white t-shirt; trainers or pumps; and a plain jumper in school colours or their school jumper/cardigan. Many of our PE sessions are outside so it is advisable that your child has kit appropriate for all weather.

Children will be participating in violin lessons with a teacher from Dudley Performing Arts.


RE:
