

Mathematics:

The main focus this term is Place Value, Addition and Subtraction and shape (2D and 3D). Please practise the 2, 5- and 10-times tables with your child at home.

English:

This term we are writing narratives and a persuasive text. Your child will also take part in weekly Whole Class Reading lessons to focus on fluency and comprehension.

Science:

Our Science will focus on plants and animals including humans. We will be learning about basic needs of animals and how plants grow and develop.

Music:

Each week children will be participating in a virtual music lesson using the Oak Academy programme.

RE/PSHE:

This term we are learning about Bible stories from the Old and New Testament, Harvest and Christmas customs. PSHE will focus on how to keep ourselves healthy, friendships including anti-bullying as well as our school values of creativity and justice.

Art:

We will be studying the works of the artist Wassily Kandinsky and creating pieces in that style.

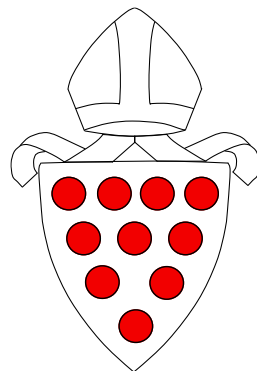
P.E:

Our PE lessons are on a Tuesday afternoon. All children are required to take part in PE lessons and should wear appropriate PE kit on this day: black leggings or jogging bottoms, a white t-shirt and trainers or pumps. They may wear their school jumper/cardigan.

Many of our PE sessions are outside so it is advisable that your child has kit appropriate for all weather.

No jewellery is permitted for health and safety reasons. Please leave getting ears pierced until the summer holidays.

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**ICT:**

The children will be learning about how to stay safe on the internet and start developing their presentation skills.

Geography:

Geography this term will include studying our local area and learning about famous local people.

Reading Books

Your child will be given a reading book weekly to read at home. Please take the time to listen to your child read and sign their reading record log so that the book can be changed.

Homework

Homework will be given out on a Tuesday, and will need to be returned on the following Tuesday. Late homework will not be marked. Children will be responsible for bringing in their own homework and if they lose their homework book, they will need to inform their class teacher straight away.

Reminders:

Your child must have a coat in school every day, even if it's not raining. Water bottles need to be labelled and can only have water in them- no juice or fizzy pop. Label jumpers and coats to avoid any losses. Hair accessories need to be school colours and studs only for earrings. Long hair must be tied back/secured.
