Mathematics:

The main focus this term is knowing times tables up to 12x12 quickly, place value, the 4 operations (+ - x ÷), fractions and converting units of measure.

English:

This term we are writing setting descriptions, persuasive letters and diaries. Your child will be heard read individually in class and take part in Whole Class Reading sessions practising a variety of skills.

Science:

Our Science will focus on Electricity (changing circuits) and Light (how it travels and how we see).

Music:

Each week children will be participating in a music lesson taught by a member of staff from Dudley Performing Arts. Our first focus is rhythm.

PSHE:

Creativity and Justice.

RE:

Alongside our school values we will be exploring E-safety and anti-bullying week.

This term will be learning how to stay safe online including appropriate use social media. We will also be learning about spreadsheets.


P.E:
